We hope you are all well and surviving this unique time in NZ's history. As you may/may not be aware term two begins on Wednesday 15th April. School will be closed until further notice, therefore we will begin our home learning programme on this date.

While our school is closed, we will use Seesaw as our main form of communication for home learning. Seesaw will help us work together to provide our children with meaningful learning experiences at home.

- We will be posting short daily videos of ourselves for you and your child to watch together.
- We will also include a daily challenge and any links we have sourced for the day. Please note, we have tried to provide you with links that are safe for your children to use independently.
- You will also receive a video each morning with a 'mystery reader' (this will enable your child to listen to a story each day, read by a teacher from Tātahi).

Inside your hand delivered package you will have received a Seesaw Class QR code. This will allow you/your child to post pictures/learning back to us.

Set up your child in the Seesaw Class App:

1. For devices like tablets or phones, download the **Seesaw Class App**. For laptop or desktop computers, **go to app.seesaw.me**
2. Click **I'm a Student**
3. We provided home learning codes: **Enter the text code** or **scan the QR code**.

Parents please continue to use the family app on your phones. If you have any questions, please contact your class teacher and they will be able to forward the Class App code to you.

We are acutely aware that many of you are working from home and may also have other children to supervise as well so please just do what you can, the activities are choice based.

If you have any questions, feel free to message us via Seesaw. We will be checking our Seesaw accounts regularly and look forward to interacting with the children/you over the coming weeks.
